*George Lucier has suggested the Rocky River Heritage Foundation make a presentation to the ERB concerning a request for around \$6,000 - \$8,000 from the county to match a similar Rocky River Heritage Foundation grant to the NCSU Dept. of Marine, Earth and Atmospheric Sciences (i.e. Dr. Fountain) to help finance a three-year, \$165,000+/- nutrient study of the Rocky River watershed beginning with the upper Rocky River that supplies the now impaired upper Siler City reservoir.
