

Chatham County Bicycle Plan

Major Staff Edits to draft for public review

May 23, 2011

- Modified project L26; ended at Haw River and added on-road portion to connect to Hanks Chapel Rd
- Added bike lane project S31 on Sanford Rd
- Extended project S14 south to Salisbury St; convert diagonal parking to parallel to make room for bike lanes
- Modified project S15; deleted original section north of Salisbury St and replaced with section south of Salisbury St to Sanford Rd
- Modified project L19 to follow NC 87 from US 64 Business to US 15-501 south
- Added project L31 to connect project L19 to existing signed route #3 from the south
- Modified project L17 to stop at Powell Pl; added project L32 to go to Northwood High
- Deleted project L21; not needed since there are existing shoulders on 15-501
- Modified project L1 to end at Cottage Grove Ave; added project L33 to go to Old US 421 as road widening and signage
- Added project L34, Love's Creek Greenway Ext, to connect from downtown Siler City to Pittsboro via shared use path
- Reassigned a portion of project L1 to be signage instead of bike lane restriping
- Added project S28; signage on Progress Blvd and Alston Chapel Rd
- Added project S29; signage on Silk Hope Liberty Rd to connect Rte. 5 and NC 6/Piedmont Spur
- Modified project L2; split eastern portion as widening, not striping
- Added project L35, restripe/widen MLK Way for bike lanes
- Added paragraph on complete streets to section 4.2
