Connector Routes

Suggested Connector Routes are highlighted on the map but are not marked with signs. These routes connect main routes with towns and points of interest and provide connections to neighboring county bicycle route systems.

The Goldston-Bennett-Bonlee Loop (35 miles) provides a scenic loop in the southwestern corner of the county. Traveling clockwise from Goldston fees description under Boute 3), the route passes Goldston Park ★ where there is a pionic area. Wooded rulling, hills lead through thropes Crossroads to Rement. The Cruthfield Crossroads-Alamanca Co. Connector (2, 25m.) provides a direct connection via S.R. 104 to Snow Camp where it intersects with the Alamance County Baylor Boute system. Maps of these routes can be obtained from the Office of Baylet and Pedestrian Transportation (see Resources section for address).

The Jordan Lake Connector Routes provide access to Jordan Lake. Its expansive visues, recreational opportunities and uniping areas are a primary destination for many cyclists.
