The Chatham County Board of Elections met at the Board of Elections office, 984-D Thompson Street, Pittsboro, NC 27312 to Canvass the October 8, 2019 Cary Municipal Election. The following people were present, Chair, Laura Heise, Secretary, Charles Ramos, Member, Amy Meek, Member, Mark Barroso, Member, Brian Bock, (by teleconference) Director, Pandora Paschal, and Deputy Director, Steve Simos.

Chair, Laura Heise called the meeting to order. The board reviewed all returns from early voting, Election Day, Absentee mail, Supplemental Absentee, and Provisional voting. Number of ballots cast for this election was 398 and total voters with history was 398.

The board completed the County Canvass Abstract Cover Sheet, and it was notarized by the Director of Elections, Pandora Paschal.
