

CHATHAM COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS MEETING MINUTES

November 19, 2019 – 5:30 P.M.

The Chatham County Board of Elections met at the Board of Elections office, 984-D Thompson Street, Pittsboro, NC 27312 on November 19, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. for their Regular Meeting. The following people were present, Chair, Laura Heise, Secretary, Charles Ramos, Member, Amy Meek, Member, Brian Bock, Member, Director, Pandora Paschal and Deputy Director, Steve Simos.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Laura Heise. She welcomed everyone to the meeting. The board approved minutes from the November 14, 2019, supplemental/provisional meeting, and the minutes from the November 15, 2019 Canvass meeting. Charles Ramos made the motion to approve the minutes and Amy Meek, seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Chair, Laura Heise gave the citizens present the opportunity to make comments about topics relating to elections and voting. Most of the citizens made comments about early voting, stating they would like Sunday voting, generous voting hours and the sites staffed well. The board assured them they would take their comments into considerations before they vote on early voting plans.

The Director, Pandora Paschal, gave the board legislative updates pertaining to voter photo ID, and absentee voting by mail for the upcoming Primary Election to be held on March 3, 2020.

All board members were not present at the meeting to have a unanimous vote on early voting plans. Amy Meek made the motion to recess the meeting until November 20, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. Charles Ramos seconded the motion and all present were in favor.
