

## **Resolution Proclaiming April 2010 as Sexual Assault Awareness Month in Chatham County**

**Whereas** sexual assault affects every person in Chatham County, as a victim/survivor or as a family member, friend, neighbor or co-worker of a victim/survivor; and

**Whereas** at least 130 community members from Chatham County sought services for sexual assault last year; and

**Whereas** staff and volunteers of Family Violence and Rape Crisis Services and many community partner agencies are promoting prevention education by offering training to schools, churches, civic organizations and the community; and

**Whereas** law enforcement, medical providers, mental health practitioners, prosecutors, probation and parole, victim advocates and human services agencies are collaborating to improve the community response to sexual assault and to provide safety, coordination through the Coalition for Family Peace and services to survivors while holding perpetrators accountable; and

**Whereas** it is critical to increase public awareness of sexual assault and child sexual abuse, to educate people about the need for community involvement in efforts to reduce violence, to increase support for agencies providing sexual violence services; and


**Whereas** the members of the Coalition for Family Peace request public support and assistance as they continue to work toward a society where all children, women and men can live in peace, free from violence and exploitation.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Chatham County Board of Commissioners, does hereby proclaim April 2010 as Sexual Assault Awareness Month in Chatham County and commends this observance to all community members.
