Resolution of the Chatham County Board of Commissioners

IN SUPPORT OF AN UPDATED ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP POLICY AND RECOGNITION OF THE GREEN TEAM

WHEREAS, in March 1999, the Chatham County Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution entitled, "Resolution in Support of Chatham County Environmental Leadership"; and

WHEREAS, as specified in such Resolution, this policy will continue to be reviewed and modified; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan continues to include goals and strategies for waste reduction, reuse, recycling, composting, purchasing recycled products, and education; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County is engaged in a contract to improve energy efficiency in County buildings and is committed to constructing new buildings to green building standards; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County actively promotes public transit, walking and biking; and

WHEREAS, the County is currently revising its land use plan to ensure responsible growth; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County recently completed a greenhouse gas emissions inventory; and

WHEREAS, protecting the environment for the benefit of future generations is in the public's interest; and

WHEREAS, compliance with environmental regulations in County government operations is the minimum expected performance level; and

WHEREAS. Chatham County has the internal expertise to integrate environmental considerations into our daily activities and optimize environmental performance throughout County operations; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County's Leadership Academy graduates have completed an assessment of environmental practices and created a sustainability index to measure the County's internal progress; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County employees have formed an internal committee (The Green Team) to identify and carry out environmental initiatives.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chatham County Board of Commissioners adopts the updated Chatham County Environmental Leadership Policy that will allow the County to serve as a model of environmental stewardship for local governments, businesses, and industry, and commits County employees to using and applying the County's existing and future resources wisely for the benefit of citizens.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The Green Team is recognized as an internal committee, and is authorized to identify, evaluate, and recommend action on environmental aspects of County operations that warrant examination, modification or corrective action; coordinate implementation and education of approved environmental initiatives; report findings and accomplishments; and update the Environmental Leadership Policy as needed.
