

**RESOLUTION**  
**Declaring Personal Property Surplus and Authorizing the County  
Manager to Dispose of Personal Property**

**WHEREAS**, by authority of N.C.G.S. 160A-266, counties may declare surplus any personal property owned by the County, sell the property by private negotiation and sale; and authorize an appropriate official to dispose of said property in private sale, and

**WHEREAS**, the Chatham County Historic Courthouse was heavily damaged by fire on March 25, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, Chatham County has stored materials including charred beams, copper roofing, scrap mahogany wainscoting and two pews; and

**WHEREAS**, Chatham County would like to look at several options in the disposal of the stated items salvaged from the fire; and


**WHEREAS**, Chatham County desires to declare said items as surplus and delegate authority to Charlie Horne, County Manager to dispose of said items by way of any methods set forth within the North Carolina General Statutes; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Chatham that the property identified above is declared surplus and authority is granted to Charlie Horne, County Manager to complete the disposals by way of approved methods within the North Carolina General Statutes.
