A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2009 AS "CHATHAM HABITAT FOR HUMANITY MONTH"

WHEREAS, Chatham Habitat for Humanity was incorporated on October 10, 1989 in order to implement the gospel of Jesus Christ by working with economically disadvantaged people in Chatham County, North Carolina, to help them create a better human habitat in which to live and work; and

WHEREAS, Chatham Habitat for Humanity has been affiliated in good standing with Habitat for Humanity International since 1989; and

WHEREAS, Chatham Habitat for Humanity has defined its mission to work in partnership with God and people to create self-help opportunities for families to own affordable homes, improve their lives and strengthen their communities; and

WHEREAS, Chatham Habitat for Humanity has constructed 89 homes in partnership with families: 43 in Pittsboro, 40 in Siler City, 4 in Bear Creek, 1 in New Hill, and 1 in Moncure; and

WHEREAS, Chatham Habitat for Humanity has worked actively and cooperatively for 20 years with local government, churches, businesses, communities, and individuals to achieve its mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County that October 2009 is hereby declared and proclaimed to be "Chatham Habitat for Humanity Month" in Chatham County.
