## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCENTIVES CONTRACT WITH ATC PANELS

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 158-7.1 authorizes a county to undertake an economic development project by extending assistance to a company in order to cause the company to locate or expand its operations within the county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County has held a public hearing to consider whether to enter into an economic development incentives grant agreement with ATC Panels (ATC) for a an expansion to its manufacturing facility in Chatham County, NC

WHEREAS, ATC Panels is expected to invest property with a tax value of \$13,000,000.00 in land cost, building, plant facility, and equipment at its Chatham County facility creating at least 25 new, permanent jobs in Chatham County; and

WHEREAS, this economic development project will stimulate, diversify, and stabilize the local economy, promote business in the County, and result in the creation of a substantial number of jobs in the County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHATHAM COUNTY:

- 1. That a contract between the County and ATC Panels in accordance with the Economic Development Incentive Policy is approved.
- 2. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to execute the contract and any other documents necessary to the project on behalf of the County.
