HONORING THE SERVICE OF COMMISSIONER BUNKEY MORGAN

WHEREAS, Bunkey Morgan began his service as a Chatham County Commissioner prior to officially taking office when he appeared at the Emergency Operations Center after the ice storm of 2002 and offered to help in any way; and
