Here are photos of the current landscaping. We do not plan to remove much. The rose bushes in front of the house will be removed and the kennel will be about where the house is. We will plant a few green bushes in front on the kennel building to help camouflage the building. The building will extend toward the back of the property. We should not need to remove any trees in the back. It is possible that one it two trees may need to be removed toward the left side (south side) where the house is to ensure access around the entire building for both maintenance and to meet fire codes. Our intention is to try to only make necessary changes but to leave the landscape as similar as possible to what it currently is.

The parking lot area will be the area in front of where the house is located and currently has stones. We will most likely add some additional stone to give it a fresher look. The parking lot will have one concrete space located close to the building for handicap accessibility.


There will be a sign located close to the road next to the driveway that will meet code requirements.


