RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO CLOSE

THIS MATTER came on to be heard before the Chatham County Board of Commissioners upon a petition filed on the 2/st day of March, 2005, to close certain portions of two streets and certain alleyways in the Village of Bennett;

AND WHEREAS, it appears the petition is in proper order and the matter should be set for public hearing in accordance with N.C. G.S. § 153A-241;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of <u>Commissioner Cherson</u>, seconded by <u>Commissioner Dutz</u>, and passed by a vote of <u>5-0</u>, the Chatham County Board of Commissioners do hereby resolve its intent to close the public roads and alleyway described in the Petition and set the question of said closing for a public hearing on <u>June 20</u>, 2005.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a notice of the public hearing shall be published once a week for three successive weeks prior to the hearing. A copy of this resolution shall be sent by certified mail to each owner adjoining the public road or alleyways who did not join in the petition and that a notice of the closing and public

hearing shall be prominently posted at least two places along the section of roads to be closed.
