RESOLUTION OF INTENT  
TO CLOSE

THIS MATTER came on to be heard before the Chatham County Board of Commissioners upon a petition filed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2005, to close certain portions of two streets and certain alleyways in the Village of Bennett;


AND WHEREAS, it appears the petition is in proper order and the matter should be set for public hearing in accordance with N.C. G.S. § 153A-241;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Commissioner Emerson, seconded by Commissioner Outz, and passed by a vote of 5-0, the Chatham County Board of Commissioners do hereby resolve its intent to close the public roads and alleyway described in the Petition and set the question of said closing for a public hearing on June 20, 2005.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a notice of the public hearing shall be published once a week for three successive weeks prior to the hearing. A copy of this resolution shall be sent by certified mail to each owner adjoining the public road or alleyways who did not join in the petition and that a notice of the closing and public

hearing shall be prominently posted at least two places along the section of roads to be closed.
