RE : WATERSHED ORDINANCE, Text Amendment, Revised 19 November 2020

Rachael,

I undertook to revise proposed Watershed Ordinance Text Amendment as we discussed yesterday, and the revision with changes tracked is attached.

The changes and comments are:

- 1. Section 302.
 - (a) All proposed edits are deleted.
 - (b) The language we discussed in inserted. The "Mixed Use Cluster Residential" sentence tracks the Zoning text, that comes from the CCO.
- 2. Section 109. General Definitions.
 - The definition "Mixed Use" is changed to "Mixed Use Cluster Residential" and the definition is edited accordingly.
 - The definition of <u>Conservation Space</u> is added. That definition comes from the existing Subdivision Regulations.
 - In paratheses I included the minimum and maximum of natural and maximum open spaces. Of course that is not necessary here and can be deleted. I just did not know how much you think best to bring over from the Subdivision Regs.
 - A cite to the Subdivision Regs is included—that is optional.

I did not include definitions of "natural space" or "open space." Those terms are already used in the Watershed Ordinance without definition.

- 3. Section 303
 - (A) The reference to Section 302 is revised to be "302(b)."
 - (B) No change
 - (C) Capitalized the defined term "Conservation Space.

--To the last paragraph, I inserted "Conservation Space" to make it clear that all of the Conservation Space is to be conveyed to the POA or have a maintenance agreement, not just the open space portion.

Rachael, and everyone, please let me know if this conforms to what you suggested, and let me know of any suggested changes.
