

CHATHAM COUNTY

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation anticipates July 2004 an allocation of \$1,494,824 and remaining funds of \$0 from the North Carolina **Highway Trust Fund**, a total of \$1,494,824 for Secondary Road Improvements in Chatham County for the forthcoming fiscal year. A public meeting was held on May 3, 2004 in the Chatham County Agriculture Auditorium on the expenditures of said funds:
