**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) asked the State of North Carolina to pull together a team of top emergency management professionals to assist the State of Florida; and



**WHEREAS**, while Janet experienced difficult working conditions, including military-style accommodations, and saw heart-wrenching sites of people who had lost everything, she learned much from her experience that will be valuable to Chatham County's emergency management efforts;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County, North Carolina, that we hereby honor Janet Scott for her extraordinary service to the State of Florida and its residents.
