
RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING NO BOAT ZONE

WHEREAS, under authority of North Carolina Statutes Section 75A-15(a) any subdivision of the State of North Carolina may at any time, after public notice, make formal application to the Wildlife Resources Commission for special rules and regulations with reference to the safe and reasonable operation of vessels on any water within its territorial limits; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County has given public notice of its intention to make formal application to the Wildlife Resources Commission for special rules and regulations with reference to the safe and reasonable operation of vessels on the Jordan Lake within the territorial limits of Chatham County, and for the implementation of the Uniform Waterway Marker System in all the waters of the County.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that in accordance with G.S. 75A-15, the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County requests the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission to promulgate special rules and regulations with reference to safe and reasonable operation of vessels on the waters of Jordan Lake Located in said County, the pertinent substance of which proposed regulations is as follows: prohibit operation of all boats or other watercraft in the vicinity of the Cary/Apex Water Intake (See Attached Map "Cary-Apex Water Treatment Plant Buoy Locations" dated May 2002).
