

CHATHAM COUNTY

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation anticipates July 2001 an allocation of \$1,617,570 and remaining funds of \$265,533 from the previous Secondary Construction Program, a total of \$1,883,103 for secondary road improvements in Chatham County for the forthcoming fiscal year. A public meeting was held on July 9, 2001 in the Chatham County District Court Room on the expenditures of said funds:

WHEREAS, it is proposed to retain \$440,162 of the total allocation for road additions, property owner participation paving, volunteer fire departments, rescue squad driveways, old subdivision improvement program, overruns, county surveys and right of way acquisition.

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation anticipates July 2001 an allocation of \$1,452,494 and remaining funds of \$506,000 from the North Carolina Highway Trust Fund, a total of \$1,958,494 for Secondary Road Improvements in Chatham County for the forthcoming fiscal year. A public meeting was held on July 9, 2001 in the Chatham County District Courtroom on the expenditures of said funds:
