WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation anticipates July 2000 an allocation of \$1,538,301 and remaining funds of \$0 from the previous Secondary Construction Program, a total of \$1,538,301 for secondary road improvements in Chatham County for the forthcoming fiscal year. A public meeting was held on June 5, 2000 in the Chatham County Agricultural Auditorium on the expenditures of said funds:

WHEREAS, it is proposed to retain \$176,193 of the total allocation for spot stabilization, paved road improvements, replace small bridges with pipe, or safety projects.


WHEREAS, it is proposed to retain \$42,438 of the total allocation for property owner participation paving and overruns.
