A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE TRANSFER OF CONTROL OF THE CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE FROM TIME WARNER, INCL., TO AOL-TIME WARNER, INC., AND A TRANSFER OF CONTROL FROM MEDIA ONE GROUP, INC., TO AT&T CORPORATION

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2000, the Franchising Authority adopted a resolution relating to the transfer of control of a cable television franchise from Time Warner, Inc., to AOL-Time Warner, Inc., and a transfer of control from Media One Group, Inc., to AT&T Corporation; and

WHEREAS, since adoption of the resolution, the relevant case law relating to one of the conditions which the Franchising Authority placed upon its approval of the transfer of control has changed; and

WHEREAS, Time Warner Entertainment-Advance/New House Partnership ("TWEAN") has provided additional information and assurances to the Franchising Authority; and

WHEREAS, based upon new case law and these new assurances, the Franchising Authority desires to rescind its previous consent of the transfer of control and adopt a new resolution subject to different terms and conditions relating to its consent to the transfer of control.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that in consideration of the foregoing, the Franchising Authority hereby rescinds its previously adopted Resolution No. 00-021 dated June 19, 2000.
