WHEREAS, on March 12, 1999 the Chatham Central High School Girls Basketball Team defeated Red Springs High School 53 to 47 and claimed the 1A State Championship; and

WHEREAS, with a record of 30 and 1 and the regular season championship, the Lady Bears brought great honor to their school and coach by attaining the school's third state championship and Coach Gerald Binkley's second championship; and


