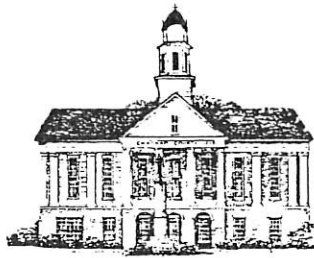

## RESOLUTION CREATING THE CHATHAM COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT I.

WHEREAS, the Chatham County Board of Commissioners has received and considered a Preliminary Engineering Report dated December 1998 entitled Stockyard Road Sewer Extension; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners on the 26th day of July 1999, after advertisement; held a Public Hearing on the subject of creation of a sewer district to be named The Chatham County Sewer District I, including territory within the boundaries as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized to form water and sewer districts pursuant to Article 6 of Chapter 162A of the General Statutes of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS it is anticipated that the District will apply for a grant from the State to cover the costs of construction of necessary lines and apparatus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners finds:

A. That there exists a demonstrable need for providing sewer services in the district as defined below; and

B. The residents of the territory encompassed in the district will benefit from the District's creation; and


C. It is economically feasible to provide the proposed service in the district without unreasonable or burdensome annual tax levies.

Section 2. Chatham County Sewer District I is hereby created. The district shall consist of all territory lying within the area extending 1,100 feet on either side of the centerline of Stockyard Road BEGINNING at a point representing the center of the intersection of Stockyard Road (SR 1106) with Bish Road (SR 1105) and running thence easterly along the centerline of Stockyard Road, thence southerly along the centerline of Stockyard Road to a point in the center of its intersection with US Highway 64, but EXCLUDING therefrom any area which lies within the city limits of the Town of Siler City, and also excluding any area which lies West of Bish Road.

Section 3. This resolution shall be published once in each of two successive weeks in the newspaper in which the notices of the public hearing were published.


Section 4. Any resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.


