RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR ABANDONING THE EXISTING RAILROAD CROSSING OF 1912 AND ADDING A NEW ALIGNMENT

Whereas, North Carolina Department of Transportation has been working for over one year to re-align Christian Chapel Road (SR 1912) to create a cross intersection with the off-ramp of northbound US 1;

Whereas, the creation of a re-aligned Christian Chapel Road will facilitate truck traffic to Triangle Brick, Elkins Sawmill, and future business development in the Merry Oaks area,

Whereas, this re-aligned road will remove truck traffic from in front of residences on King Road (SR 1911) and a part of the existing Christian Chapel Road (SR 1912); and


Whereas, existing King Road and Christian Chapel Road will remain in their current condition and be maintained as State roads.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Chatham County Board of Commissioners support the abandonment of the existing railroad crossing over CSX Transportation railroad lines between Old US 1 (SR 1011) and the existing roadway of King Road (SR 1911) where it intersects with Christian Chapel Road (SR 1912), a distance of approximately 245 feet.


Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Chatham County Board of Commissioners supports the addition of the new alignment of Christian Chapel Road (SR 1912), from Old US 1 (SR 1011) at the off-ramp to a point on Christian Chapel Road (SR 1912), approximately 1,1785 feet.

The Chatham County Board of Commissioners supports the establishment of a new railroad crossing to facilitate the re-alignment of Christian Chapel Road to better traffic patterns and eliminate significant traffic in front of area residences. This new railroad crossing and re-aligned roadway must be completed before abandonment of the existing railroad crossing referenced above.
