

CHATHAM COUNTY

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation anticipates July 1998 an allocation of \$313,107 and remaining funds of \$34,367 from the previous Secondary Construction Program, a total of \$1,347,474 for secondary road improvements in Chatham County for the forthcoming fiscal year. A public meeting was held on June 1, 1998 in the Chatham County Courthouse Annex on the expenditures of said funds:

A public meeting was held on June 1, 1998 in the Chatham County Courthouse Annex on the expenditures of said funds:

A public meeting was held on June 1, 1998 in the Chatham County Courthouse Annex on the expenditures of said funds:
