Resolution In Support of Gasoline Tax Proceeds Being Returned to the Various Counties in North Carolina

WHEREAS, Jordan Lake was completed in 1979 and encompasses 150 miles of shoreline and a surface area of more than 14,000 acres; and

WHEREAS, many occupational, educational, and recreational opportunities abound in the lake area; and

WHEREAS, boating safety and the lack of funds for law enforcement is a concern for both the residents of the Jordan Lake area and the many other people who utilize the Lake for occupational and recreational purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, we the Chatham County Board of Commissioners, do hereby request that the General Assembly of North Carolina design and support legislation to designate that the tax on fuel used by the various watercraft vessels be refunded back to the Counties in which the sale of the fuel was transacted.
