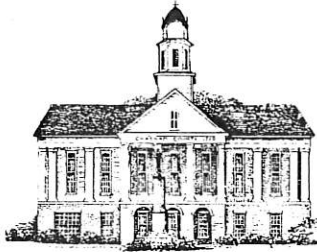

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the safety, health, and well being of Chatham County citizens is greatly enhanced by its abundant natural resources; and

**WHEREAS**, this environment is now being impacted by damage being created by an increased beaver population; and


**WHEREAS**, the ability of landowners, County and State government, and timber companies are being materially affected by the increased population of beavers; and

**WHEREAS**, conditions exist that require some type of beaver management program; and


**WHEREAS**, interested landowners have expressed the need for a Beaver Damage Control Program in Chatham County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Chatham, North Carolina, that the board supports legislation that will provide proper management of beaver populations, thus reducing the damage of our natural resources. Chatham County asks that the beaver damage control pilot program established by Section 69 of Chapter 1044 of the 1991 Session Laws as amended by Section 111 of Chapter 561 of the 1993 Session Laws and amended by Senate Bill 1505 (page 142) in 1994 be continued in FY 1995-96. Chatham County asks to be included in this legislation or any new legislation related to beaver damage control for FY 1995-96.
