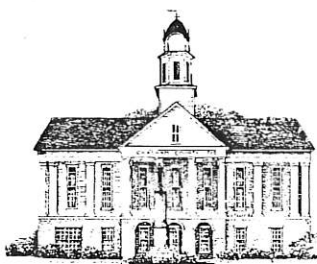

RESOLUTION **SECONDARY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM** **AND** **SECONDARY IMPROVEMENT SUPPLEMENT, TRUST FUND** **1994-1995**

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation anticipates July 1994 an allocation of \$1,112,298 and remaining funds of \$0.00 from the previous Secondary Construction Program, a total of \$1,112,298, for secondary road improvements in Chatham County for the forthcoming fiscal year. A public hearing was held on June 6, 1994 in the County Courthouse Annex on the expenditures of said funds:

WHEREAS, it is proposed to utilize approximately \$797,000 to construct roads down the priority list as far as possible, provided rights of way are available:

WHEREAS, it is proposed to retain \$161,977 of the total allocation for spot stabilization, paved road improvements, replace small bridges with pipe, or safety projects.

WHEREAS, it is proposed to retain \$153,321 of the total allocation for road additions, property owner participation paving, volunteer fire departments, rescue squad driveways, old subdivision improvement program, overruns, county surveys and right of way acquisition.

WHEREAS, it is proposed to utilize approximately \$588,800 to construct roads down the priority list as far as possible, provided rights of way are available:



WHEREAS, it is proposed to retain \$32,540 of the total allocation for property owner participating paving and overruns.


BE IT RESOLVED, that all of the above be carried out by the Department of Transportation.
