RESOLUTION

Declaring Property Surplus and Authorizing the Sale of Said Property to the North Chatham Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.

Section 1: The property identified above is declared surplus;

Section 3: In accordance with N.C. G.S. 160A-279, the property identified above shall be conveyed to North Chatham Volunteer Fire Department, Inc., in exchange for the Fire Department providing hazardous materials response services throughout the County. This conveyance shall become effective 10 days after the publication by the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners of a notice summarizing the contents of this resolution and identifying the property to be sold and its value; and

Section 4: Upon the conveyance of said property, it shall become the sole responsibility of the North Chatham Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. Said property shall be put to public use by North Chatham Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. and shall not be used for private benefit.
