## Requesting that the Farmers Home Administration Conduct a Public Hearing and Develop an Environmental Impact Statement

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Timothy Craig have applied for financial assistance from the Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) to construct five (5) swine finishing houses, a lagoon, and related site development in the area of S.R. 2210, approximately three (3) miles southeast of Siler City in Chatham County; and

WHEREAS, the FmHA proposes to act on this request without holding a public hearing and without developing an environmental impact statement; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham County Board of Commissioners believes that a facility of this type has the potential for many negative impacts on adjoining property owners, including residences and farms, and on the adjoining Rocky River; and

**WHEREAS**, these impacts should be studied thoroughly before any action is taken on this request by developing an environmental impact statement and conducting a public hearing to allow adjoining residences the opportunity to comment on this request;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Chatham that we do hereby request that the Farmers Home Administration hold a public hearing and develop an environmental impact statement before any action is taken on the Craigs' request.
