Wastewater treatment for Granville Subdivision will be provided by Fearrington Utilities, LLC. The sewer collection mains for Granville will discharge into the Fearrington mains on Tyrrell. The collection mains and pump station in Fearrington receiving wastewater from Granville have sufficient capacity to serve Granville.

The current situation at the Fearrington WWTP can be summarized as follows:
