Cara Townsend gave a presentation to the Board. (Presentation attached) Cara said Jennie Kristiansen is a thought leader and provokes a lot of thought within the region and they really enjoy working with her.

Heather Johnson and Trevor are good example of a success story. Heather is on the regional and state committee.

In NC, we have typically been facility based instead of family based with the welfare system. State is currently working on a plan - CFSP. There are pros and cons to the plan. The plan is not fully worked out. The devil is in the details. Vaya is very concerned about the providers and the timeline of this plan.

Chatham sent a letter to the NC Sec. of DHHS and so did the NCACC.

Karen - how do we work out our providers so residents on the borders of counties not continguous for our region? Cara - we can have some providers come to the clients here in Chatham. Karen - hopefully this will inspire providers to expand their services.

Diana - Burlington must be the largest metro area in our region? Cara - yes.

Diana - asked Cara to connect with second bloom. She can give Cara contact info.

Robert - school systems also partner with agencies to bring services to their students. What type of relationships do you have with the school districts in the region. Cara we do have partnerships, they are working well but could be better. They are looking for creative solutions - especially due to the increased suicide rate. Robert would like to talk to her more about that. He doesn't think the general public is aware of the increased mental health stress on students today. We need to take more steps for preventive care and immediate treatment.

Karen - schools did have a partnership, not sure if it was under Cardinal or not. Doesn't know if that is ongoing?
