Here are the comments I submitted to Kimberly on April 19th, 2021:

On behalf of the Chatham County Historical Association (CCHA), I have reviewed the proposed Ridgecrest subdivision site (Tax Parcel #1798), and have the following comments:

• The CCHA is unaware of any cemeteries or burial sites on the property; however, if any evidence of gravesites should be discovered, the CCHA would like to be notified immediately.

• The site is located adjacent to the old Hillsboro Road (now abandoned), which forms the parcel's eastern boundary (see Plats 12-96,12-98 & 2019-305); the site is also located in the general area of the former Pace & Cotton Mill (which appears to have been located on Wilkerson's Creek east of the old Hillsboro Road, see the 1870 Ramsey map); therefore, there exists a higher-than-normal probability that artifacts of historical interest (e.g., wagon wheels, mill stones) may be located on the site. The CCHA requests that it be informed if any artifacts are encountered during surveying or development, so that they may be documented and/or preserved by the CCHA.

• If evidence of any past structures are found, or if any other features of potential interest, such as walls, foundations, or wells are discovered, these should be brought to the attention of the CCHA, which may request photos and/or a site visit.

• As a general rule, the CCHA encourages developers to preserve our local county history by naming developments and/or roads for former occupants or uses. In this case, the site was part of the land holdings of the Gattis family for almost 100 years (until 1970, see attached deed summary). Therefore, the CCHS would encourage the developer to incorporate the name Gattis into its proposal.
