Include proposed uses of the property. Please describe your development plans. The existing 52.17 acre site has two existing dwelling units and some cleared area in the center of the site. The site contains numerous buffered streams, wetlands, and some young growth pine stands. The proposed development is a +/- 32 lot conservation subdivision, as allowed by the Chatham County Land Development Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations. There are no Primary or Secondary Natural Areas, Heritage Areas, Wildlife or Upland System Areas, or Historical/Cultural Resources. As mentioned above, the site will be a Conservation Subdivision and will ultimately have over 80% of the site which is not developed upon. Great care has been taken in design to minimize stream/wetland crossings. There are existing stream crossings of all 4 on site streams. The development will propose to modify two of these existing crossings, as Feature A and Feature B in order to construct the required roadways. The roads will be ditch section and all stormwater will be handled on-site though the use of a Wet Detention Pond to meet or exceed all Chatham County Stormwater requirements for water quality and quantity.
