Chatham County Water Utilities to Implement Water Rate Increase

PITTSBORO, NC— On June 17, 2024, the Chatham County Board of Commissioners approved the County's Fiscal Year 2024-25 budget, which includes a water rate increase for approximately 11,200 Water Utilities customers.

Effective July 1, 2024, there will be a 15% water rate increase for Chatham County Water Utilities customers. Although this is effective July 1st, customers will not see the increase until their bill arrives in September. For example, the average monthly water bill of \$43.00 would increase by \$6.45 to \$49.45.

It is important to note that the water usage rates have not increased since 2007. This increase is needed to meet rising operational costs and necessary capital improvements.
