DESIGN DRIVERS

RELATE

- Familiar architectural language, materials, and hierarchy
- Appeal to agricultural lifestyle, strong sense of community (small-town, everyone knows everyone),
 pride of history
- Humble procession (entry is welcoming, not overbearing)
- Sensitive to scale, sensitive to history

PROCLAIM

- · Introduce something new
- Assign significance
- Peak interest through contrast (material change, dynamic façade moves)
- Use the building form to address surrounding communities ("reaching out" to Chapel Hill and Pittsboro)

EMPOWER

- Promote sense of community ownership
- Building addresses human scale (the individual is important to the success of the whole)
- Achieve through secondary moves? (texture, color, projections)
- Engage and connect to the exterior through projections (overhangs, reveals, canopies, openings)
