#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is between the Chatham County Partnership for Children (the "Partnership") and Chatham County (the "County"). The purpose of the MOU is to establish a partnership for the implementation of Kaleidoscope Play and Learn program. This MOU outlines the responsibilities of each party for Kaleidoscope Play and Learn parent education groups.

## I. The County agrees to:

- A. Provide use of Southwest District Park on Friday mornings from 9 am to 12 pm throughout the fiscal year 2025-2026 for Kaleidoscope Play and Learn parent education groups at no cost to the Partnership.
- B. Advertise Kaleidoscope Play and Learn through social media platforms operated by the County's Parks and Recreation Department and by making program related materials available to clientele.
- C. Advertise Kaleidoscope Play and Learn at County parks.
- D. Provide marketing materials, including logos to be used, available to the Partnership for advertising play groups.
- E. Notify Partnership of conflicting dates or park closures.

### II. The Partnership agrees to:

- A. Ensure that the park is left clean and ready for the next use, including moving picnic tables to their original location and cleaning up any mess that is made.
- B. Submit for approval by the County prior to use any materials that display any County logo providing information on play groups held on County property.
- C. Follow all posted park rules and regulations.

#### III. Termination

Either party, upon thirty (30) days written notice, may terminate this MOU in whole or in part, at any time before the expiration date.

#### IV. Indemnification Clause:

Chatham County Partnership for Children and/or it's participants hereby indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the County from and against any and all claims, losses, liability and damages (present and future) and all costs, charges and fees (including reasonable attorneys' fees) related thereto, arising out of or in any way connected with participation in the "Kaleidoscope Play and Learn Group". Including, without limitation to the extent permitted by law, any claim, loss, liability or damage related (directly or indirectly) to acts or omissions (negligent or otherwise) of the County.
