
## Watershed Protection Department Riparian Buffer Maze

Riparian buffers are the vegetated areas that protect rivers and ponds from a variety of pollutants that flow downhill during rain showers. These streamside buffers can provide a number of benefits which may include filtering nutrients, pesticides, and animal waste from agricultural land runoff; stabilizing eroding stream banks; filtering sediment from runoff; providing shade, shelter, and food for fish and other aquatic organisms; providing wildlife habitat; protecting downstream communities from flood damage and providing space for recreation.
